Expecting Signs & Wonders
Part 4: Expecting Power Demons
April 5, 2020

Discussion Question: What demonic forces do you see at work today? Do you believe you have power over these demons through Jesus Christ!

Today is Palm Sunday... Jesus triumphal entry into Jerusalem.

Matt 21:15 *"But when the chief priests and the scribes saw the wonderful things that He had done, and the children who were shouting in the temple, "Hosanna to the Son of David," they became indignant..."* [NASU]

Anytime you do good in the name of Jesus, demons are going to raise their ugly head. Demons are displeased when we testify to the goodness of God. But on this Palm Sunday be reminded Jesus has Power over Demons and no matter how much they complain about

Any message that deals with demons comes with some dangers.

- Some love to sensationalize them and see them in every place.
- Others deny them and see any discussion as foolish.
- Others live in fear that the demons have all power
- Still others are infatuated with them and study them more than the Word of God

Today we simply want to state a simple truth. Jesus has all Power, including over Demons!

We are aware that demons can possess people. Not normative... everyone is not demon possessed; but some are. We know that demons have the power to oppress and depress.

We can give them access or footholds in our lives.

2 Cor 2:11 Forgive... *"Lest Satan should get an advantage of us: for we are not ignorant of his devices."* [KJV]

In Ephesians 6:12 we find levels known as rulers, principalities, powers, rulers of darkness & spiritual wickedness in high places.

When we encounter demons, the key is not to focus on the demon...but on the power of God.

Luke 8:22-25

1. Promise (vs. 22)

"One day he got into a boat with his disciples, and he said to them, "Let us go across to the other side of the lake." So they set out,

2. Problem (vs. 23)

"and as they sailed he fell asleep. And a windstorm came down on the lake, and they were filling with water and were in danger."

On the way to the fulfillment of a promise a storm arises. The disciples' obedience takes them into the eye of the storm. Following Jesus does not make us immune to problems; Not following HIM will not keep you out of problems either.

Storms expose what is inside of us! We either **turn to Jesus with our problem or give satan an advantage**

Demons are always trying to stir up something... a lot has been stirred up with this virus. I don't believe the virus is necessarily demonic and if someone gets it, it does not mean they have a demon. But the storm that has been created in the response to it is demonic.

Our enemy, satan; kills, steals & destroys: he hates all of humanity and looks for places to get an advantage and in this virus he found footholds in human fear.

3. Provision (vs. 24)

"And they went and woke him, saying, "Master, Master, we are perishing!" And he awoke and rebuked the wind and the raging waves, and they ceased, and there was a calm."

It is funny how we do not ask Jesus why HE put us in a boat with calm a sea on a beautiful day...rather we question HIS caring because of the storm.

But it is better to have Jesus in the boat HE put you on asleep than to be in your own by yourself! (Just ask Jonah!) Because Jesus always has a provision for the problem!

4. New Perspective (vs. 25)

"He said to them, "Where is your faith?" And they were afraid, and they marveled, saying to one another, "Who then is this, that he commands even winds and water, and they obey him?"

The Disciples asks, "Who is this..." In the boat HE had the same problem they did...an angry sea...a powerful storm trying to sink HIM... a boat taking on water! But HIS perspective was different! HE knew who HE was! The ONE with authority over the storm! This time of crisis and chaos hopefully is giving you a better perspective of Jesus Christ

5. Power over Demons

The demons did not want Jesus on the other side because there was a man in the tombs that need to be set free. Jesus has heard his cry to be free.

In this present crisis, don't lose sight:

- Jesus gives a Promise
- demons will raise up a Problem
- Jesus has a Provision
- We get a New Prospective
- Power of Christ is revealed to set people free

HE is not going to get us out of this storm to tell storm stories! No, HE wants us telling the story of the captive being set free!

vs. 39 *"Return to your home, and declare how much God has done for you." And he went away, proclaiming throughout the whole city how much Jesus had done for him.*" [ESV]

Pregunta de discusión: ¿Qué fuerzas demoníacas ves trabajando hoy? ¡Crees que tienes poder sobre estos demonios a través de Jesucristo!

Hoy es Domingo de Ramos ... Jesús entró triunfalmente en Jerusalén.

Mateo 21:15 "Pero los principales sacerdotes y los escribas, viendo las maravillas que hacía, y a los muchachos aclamando en el templo y diciendo: !!Hosanna al Hijo de David! se indignaron,"

Cada vez que hagas el bien en el nombre de Jesús, los demonios levantarán su fea cabeza. Los demonios se disgustan cuando damos testimonio de la bondad de Dios. Pero en este Domingo de Ramos, recuerden que Jesús tiene poder sobre los demonios y no importa cuánto se quejen

Cualquier mensaje que trate con demonios viene con algunos peligros.

- A algunos les encanta sensacionalizarlos y verlos en todos los lugares.
- Otros los niegan y ven cualquier discusión como tonta.
- Otros viven con miedo de que los demonios tengan todo el poder.
- Aún otros están enamorados de ellos y los estudian más que la Palabra de Dios.

Hoy simplemente queremos decir una verdad simple. ¡Jesús tiene todo el poder, incluso sobre los demonios!

Somos conscientes de que los demonios pueden poseer personas. No es normativo ... no todos están poseídos por demonios; pero algunos lo son. Sabemos que los demonios tienen el poder de oprimir y deprimir.

Podemos darles acceso o puntos de apoyo en nuestras vidas.

2 Cor 2:11 Perdona ... " para que Satanás no gane ventaja alguna sobre nosotros; pues no ignoramos sus maquinaciones."

En Efesios 6:12 encontramos niveles conocidos como gobernantes, principados, poderes, gobernantes de oscuridad y maldad espiritual en lugares altos.

Cuando nos encontramos con demonios, la clave no es enfocarnos en el demonio ... sino en el poder de Dios.

Lucas 8: 22-25

1. Promesa (vs. 22)

"Aconteció un día, que entró en una barca con sus discípulos, y les dijo: Pasemos al otro lado del lago. Y partieron."

2. Problema (vs. 23)

"Pero mientras navegaban, él se durmió. Y se desencadenó una tempestad de viento en el lago; y se anegaban y peligrosaban."

En el camino hacia el cumplimiento de una promesa, surge una tormenta. La obediencia de los discípulos los lleva al ojo de la tormenta. Seguir a Jesús no nos hace inmunes a los problemas; No seguirlo a EL tampoco lo mantendrá fuera de problemas.

¡Las tormentas exponen lo que hay dentro de nosotros! O recurrimos a Jesús con nuestro problema o le damos a Satanás una ventaja

Los demonios siempre están tratando de despertar algo ... se ha despertado mucho con este virus. No creo que el virus sea necesariamente demoníaco y si alguien lo contrae, no significa que tenga un demonio. Pero la tormenta que se ha creado en respuesta a ella es demoníaca.

Nuestro enemigo, satanás; mata, roba y destruye: odia a toda la humanidad y busca lugares para obtener una ventaja y en este virus encontró puntos de apoyo en el miedo humano.

3. Disposición (vs. 24)

"Y vinieron a él y le despertaron, diciendo: ¡Maestro, Maestro, que perecemos! Despertando él, reprendió al viento y a las olas; y cesaron, y se hizo bonanza."

Es curioso cómo no le preguntamos a Jesús por qué nos puso en un bote con la calma del mar en un hermoso día ... más bien cuestionamos su preocupación por la tormenta.

¡Pero es mejor tener a Jesús en el bote que te durmió que estar solo en tu casa! (¡Solo pregúntale a Jonás!) ¡Porque Jesús siempre tiene una provisión para el problema!

4. Nueva perspectiva (vs. 25)

“Y les dijo: ¿Dónde está vuestra fe? Y atemorizados, se maravillaban, y se decían unos a otros: ¿Quién es éste, que aun a los vientos y a las aguas manda, y le obedecen?”

Los Discípulos preguntan: "¿Quién es este ...?" En el bote EL tuvo el mismo problema que ellos ... un mar enojado ... una tormenta poderosa tratando de hundirlo ... ¡un bote que se sumerge en el agua! ¡Pero SU perspectiva era diferente! ¡Él sabía quién era! ¡El que tiene autoridad sobre la tormenta! Con suerte, este tiempo de crisis y caos te está dando una mejor perspectiva de Jesucristo

5. Poder sobre los demonios

Los demonios no querían a Jesús del otro lado porque había un hombre en las tumbas que debía ser liberado. Jesús ha escuchado su grito de ser libre.

En esta crisis actual, no pierdas de vista:

- o Jesús hace una promesa
- o demonios plantearán un problema
- o Jesús tiene una provisión
- o Tenemos una nueva perspectiva
- o El poder de Cristo se revela para liberar a las personas

¡Él no nos va a sacar de esta tormenta para contar historias de tormenta! ¡No, ÉL quiere que contemos la historia de la liberación del cautivo!

vs. 39 " Vuélvete a tu casa, y cuenta cuán grandes cosas ha hecho Dios contigo. Y él se fue, publicando por toda la ciudad cuán grandes cosas había hecho Jesús con él."
