Part 4: Expecting Power Over Sickness & Disease

March 29, 2020

Discussion Question: What do the stripes on Jesus back mean to you? Have you ever been healed from a sickness – if so testify!

REVIEW

Our expectation is not for God to prove Himself

An expectation is simply **a strong belief that something will happen, or someone will or should achieve something.**

Ps 62:5 “My soul, wait thou only upon God; for my expectation is from him.” [KJV]

Herein lies the great truth for those who follow Christ. Our expectations are from HIM...not me developing an expectation and putting it on HIM but true expectation (hope) finds its source in HIM.

An example of that is Expecting HIS Power over Supply

Phil 4:18 “But my God shall supply all your need according to his riches in glory by Christ Jesus.” [KJV]

TODAY: Expecting Power over Disease

One of the great characteristics of God is HIS power over disease. All sickness & disease comes from the fall of man and the devil. God is good in HIM dwells no unrighteousness.

God has all power, including Power Over Sickness & Disease

Ps 107:19-20 "Then they cry unto the Lord in their trouble, and he saveth them out of their distresses. 20 He sent his word, and healed them, and delivered them from their destructions." [KJV]

HE is a healer...we all will die one day, but we the people of God will die in faith and that very well may be our healing moment!

I. Provision in Christ Work (Cried unto the Lord)

The work of Christ on the cross involves our healing.

Isaiah 53:3 "But he was wounded for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities: the chastisement of our peace was upon him; and with his stripes we are healed." [KJV]

If you believe that Christ death & resurrection has enough power to cleanse you of sin, then so to the same power to give you victory over sickness and disease.

Ex 15:26 "...for I am the Lord that healeth thee." [KJV]

When Jesus said HE came that we might have life HE was indicating something more than just making it through life. Life is defined as **the absolute fullness of life, both essential and ethical, which belongs to God**

1 Peter 2:24 "Who his own self bare our sins in his own body on the tree, that we, being dead to sins, should live unto righteousness: by whose stripes ye were healed." [KJV]

II. Power of HIS Name (Sent His Word – Jesus is the Word)

Luke 10:18-20 "And he said unto them, I beheld Satan as lightning fall from heaven. 19 Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and **over all the power of the enemy**: and nothing shall by any means hurt you. 20 Notwithstanding in this rejoice not, that the spirits are subject unto you; but rather rejoice, because your names are written in heaven." [KJV]

Jesus is a healer and satan is a fallen oppressor of mankind!

Proverbs 4:20-22 "My son, give attention to my words; Incline your ear to my sayings. 21 Do not let them depart from your sight; Keep them in the midst of your heart. 22 For they are life to those who find them And health to all their body." [NASU]

III. Privilege in HIS Name (Healed & Delivered)

Rom 8:1-2 "There is therefore now no condemnation to them which are in Christ Jesus, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit. 2 For the **law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus** hath made me free from the law of sin and death." [KJV]

There are laws we live with (Ex: Law of Gravity) We trust these laws

When we live in the Law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus we are free from the dominion of sin. Sin can't dominate us!

Many of us are not living in that freedom; we are living in the Spirit of fear that disease will overtake us ... but family, the life of faith embraces the journey that God has for us and trust HIM with our life

We are not speaking of foolishness; I will not walk in front of a speeding train and say I have faith; I will not walk out to this bridge and jump onto the interstate claiming faith

Faith is always bound up in truth... and the truth is that if we are in Christ, sin has no dominion over you! Even death has to wait until God gives it the orders!

Prov 3:7-8 "Do not be wise in your own eyes; Fear the Lord and turn away from evil. 8 It will be healing to your body And refreshment to your bones." [NASU]

REPASO

Nuestra expectativa no es que Dios se pruebe a sí mismo

Una expectativa es simplemente una fuerte creencia de que algo sucederá, o alguien logrará o debería lograr algo.

Salmo 62: 5 "Alma mía, en Dios solamente reposa, Porque de él es mi esperanza."

Aquí yace la gran verdad para aquellos que siguen a Cristo. Nuestras expectativas son de ÉL ... no de mí desarrollando una expectativa y poniéndola en ÉL, pero la verdadera expectativa (esperanza) encuentra su fuente en ÉL.

Un ejemplo de eso es esperar su poder sobre el suministro

Fil 4:19 "Mi Dios, pues, suplirá todo lo que os falta conforme a sus riquezas en gloria en Cristo Jesús."

HOY: Esperando poder sobre la enfermedad

Una de las grandes características de Dios es SU poder sobre la enfermedad. Toda enfermedad y dolencia proviene de la caída del hombre y del diablo. Dios es bueno en ÉL no mora en la injusticia.

Dios tiene todo el poder, incluido el poder sobre la enfermedad y la enfermedad

Salmo 107: 19-20 “Pero clamaron a Jehová en su angustia, Y los libró de sus aflicciones.

²⁰ Envió su palabra, y los sanó, Y los libró de su ruina.”

ÉL es un sanador ... todos moriremos un día, pero nosotros, el pueblo de Dios, moriremos con fe y jese muy bien puede ser nuestro momento de curación!

1. Provisión en la obra de Cristo (clamó al Señor)

La obra de Cristo en la cruz implica nuestra curación.

Isaías 53: 5 “Mas él herido fue por nuestras rebeliones, molido por nuestros pecados; el castigo de nuestra paz fue sobre él, y por su llaga fuimos nosotros curados.”

Si crees que la muerte y resurrección de Cristo tiene el poder suficiente para limpiarte del pecado, entonces con el mismo poder para darte la victoria sobre la enfermedad y la enfermedad.

Ex 15:26 "... porque yo soy Jehová tu sanador.”

Cuando Jesús dijo que ÉL vino para que pudiéramos tener vida, estaba indicando algo más que solo sobrevivir a la vida. La vida se define como la plenitud absoluta de la vida, tanto esencial como ética, que pertenece a Dios.

1 Pedro 2:24 “quien llevó él mismo nuestros pecados en su cuerpo sobre el madero, para que nosotros, estando muertos a los pecados, vivamos a la justicia; y por cuya herida fuisteis sanados.”

2. Poder de SU Nombre (Enviado Su Palabra - Jesús es la Palabra)

Lucas 10: 18-20 “Y les dijo: Yo veía a Satanás caer del cielo como un rayo. ¹⁹ He aquí os doy potestad de hollar serpientes y escorpiones, y sobre toda fuerza del enemigo, y nada os dañará. ²⁰ Pero no os regocijéis de que los espíritus se os sujetan, sino regocijaos de que vuestros nombres están escritos en los cielos.”

¡Jesús es un sanador y Satanás es un opresor caído de la humanidad!

Proverbios 4: 20-22 “Hijo mío, está atento a mis palabras; Inclina tu oído a mis razones.

²¹ No se aparten de tus ojos; Guárdalas en medio de tu corazón; ²² Porque son vida a los que las hallan, Y medicina a todo su cuerpo”

3. . Privilegio en SU Nombre (Curado y Entregado)

Rom 8: 1-2 “Ahora, pues, ninguna condenación hay para los que están en Cristo Jesús, los que no andan conforme a la carne, sino conforme al Espíritu. ² Porque la ley del Espíritu de vida en Cristo Jesús me ha librado de la ley del pecado y de la muerte.”

Hay leyes con las que vivimos (Ej: Ley de la gravedad) Confiamos en estas leyes
Cuando vivimos en la Ley del Espíritu de vida en Cristo Jesús, somos libres del dominio del pecado. ¡El pecado no puede dominarnos!

Muchos de nosotros no estamos viviendo en esa libertad; estamos viviendo en el Espíritu de temor de que la enfermedad nos alcance ... pero en familia, la vida de fe abarca el viaje que Dios tiene para nosotros y confía en ÉL con nuestra vida

No estamos hablando de tonterías; No caminaré frente a un tren a toda velocidad y diré que tengo fe; No saldré a este puente y saltaré a la interestatal reclamando fe

La fe siempre está ligada a la verdad ... y la verdad es que si estamos en Cristo, ¡el pecado no tiene dominio sobre ti! ¡Incluso la muerte tiene que esperar hasta que Dios le dé las órdenes!

Prov 3: 7-8 “No seas sabio en tu propia opinión; Teme a Jehová, y apártate del mal; ⁸ Porque será medicina a tu cuerpo, Y refrigerio para tus huesos.”
