On Sunday Pastor had this statement in his sermon notes, (which if you do not have the church app to follow along on Sunday mornings), I suggest you download it. From this statement I was reminded of the story in Acts where Phillip is led by the Spirit to talk to the Ethiopian Eunuch.

*"And the Spirit said to Philip, 'Go over and join this chariot.'"³⁰ So Philip ran to him and heard him reading Isaiah the prophet and asked, 'Do you understand what you are reading?'"³¹ And he said, "**How can I, unless someone guides me?**" And he invited Philip to come up and sit with him. "- Acts 8:29-31*

As part of our role as Christians we are called to help guide others, be it children, grandchildren, friends, or coworkers. I wanted to encourage you that as you do this in 2021 you need to be patient. Every person has a different bent, which means different ways of learning, processing, and receiving.
